

Thesis 2.1 Code Editor Keyboard Shortcuts - Mac

LEFT ARROW: move one character left

RIGHT ARROW: move one character right

UP ARROW: move one line up

DOWN ARROW: move one line down

END: move to end of line

HOME: move to beginning of line

PAGE UP: move up 1 page

PAGE DOWN: move down 1 page

DELETE: delete selected, delete character after cursor

BACKSPACE: delete character before cursor

TAB: inserts tab, indent selected

SHIFT+TAB: recreates tabbing for selected area

ENTER: new line

INSERT: toggles "overwrite" mode

CMD+A: select all

CMD+D: delete line

CMD+Z: undo

SHIFT+CMD+Z: redo

CMD+Y: redo

CMD+UP ARROW: go to the top of the document

CMD+END: go to the bottom of the document

CMD+DOWN ARROW: go to the bottom of the document

ALT+LEFT ARROW: go left 1 word

ALT+RIGHT ARROW: go right 1 word

CMD+LEFT: go to the beginning of the line

CMD+RIGHT: go to the end of the line

ALT+BACKSPACE: delete 1 word before the cursor

ALT+DELETE: delete 1 word after the cursor

CMD+S: save

CMD+F: find

CMD+G: find next

SHIFT+CMD+G: find previous

CMD+ALT+F: replace

SHIFT+CMD+ALT+F: replace all
