

BYOBWebsite Cheat Sheet - WordPress Generated Class Names

Rules for id and class names

1. Use id (#) for elements that will occur only once on a page.
2. Use class (.) for elements that may occur more than once on a page.
3. Only use lower case letters, numbers, underscore and dash (a-z, 0-9, _, -)
4. Never begin a name with a number
5. Make the names reasonably descriptive
6. Avoid WordPress generated class names
